2016 EDEN PRAIRIE ICE SHOW COSTUMES & PICTURES

SAVE THE DATE - Saturday, February 27, 2016.

This is the date the ice show pictures will be taken. Attached is a schedule that indicates a check-in time for each number in the show (which allows 30 minutes to pick up costumes and get dressed) and a picture time.

- Please come promptly at the check-in time indicated for your group.
- Costumes will be distributed prior to pictures at the Eden Prairie Community Center.
- Arrive early enough to pick up your costume, get dressed, put on skates, and touch up hair and make-up before the scheduled picture time.

Volunteers will direct skaters to dressing rooms and will be available to answer any questions. We are on a very **tight schedule** so it is important that you arrive on time. We will not be able to wait for anyone. Skaters should have someone come along to help get them into their costume.

Items to remember for picture day:

1. Polish your skates.
2. **Skate Guards are mandatory! Pictures are taken with skates on and walking on hard surfaces will ruin your blades and the floor. The guards will be taken off for photos.**
3. Girls - Wear flesh colored skating tights or sheer to waist nylons for the pictures.
4. Remember that underwear may show under some costumes, so please wear white underwear. (Most girls wear tights only.)
5. Bring hairpins and safety pins for costume and hair adjustments.
6. Bring enough blank checks for ordering pictures. If your child is in more than one number, you will need to pay with separate checks. (* See below)

* The pictures are being taken by Inter-State Studio at the **Eden Prairie Community Center (Cambria Room)**. Parents must fill out an order form for pictures on Picture Day when they are taken. Order forms will be available on Picture Day and in club room prior to picture day. If your child is in more than one picture (this includes the Club picture), your child will hand carry the order envelope into the picture room when her/his number is called. ONLY skaters will be allowed in the room where pictures are being taken.

Ordered pictures will be sent to your home. Please complete the order form carefully. Pictures of all group numbers and soloists will also be featured in the Ice Show Program. 2016 Ice Show Programs will be available for purchase during all three shows performances.

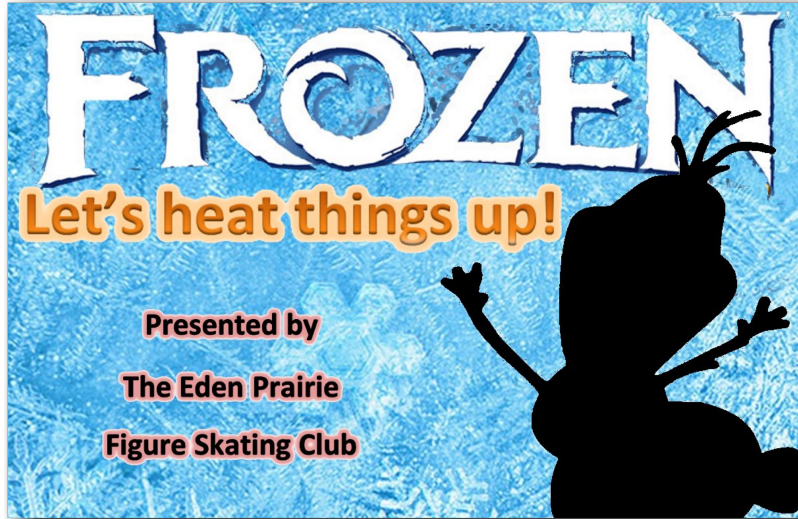

2016 EDEN PRAIRIE ICE SHOW

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES

All skaters must check in at the Skater Check-in Table (Cambria Room) to get their dressing room assignments. The Check-In Table can be accessed from either the main entrance if you are already inside the building or the “Ice Rink” entrance if you are entering the building from outside. Once skaters have their dressing room assignments, they will report to the same dressing room for each ice show performance and they do not need to stop in the Cambria room again.

After dropping off skaters, parents should proceed back through the Cambria Room and enter Rink 1 through the main entrance. There is **NO ACCESS** to the dressing rooms directly from Rink 1 at any time. All skaters and parents must enter the dressing room area through the Cambria room. This is to ensure the safety of skaters and to minimize confusion in the back stage area.

Once they have been dropped off, skaters will wait in the dressing rooms with parent chaperone volunteers until it is time to go on the ice. Skaters will then be ushered by chaperones between the dressing rooms and Rink 1 for their performances.

All skaters will remain in the backstage area until either intermission or after the finale, depending on the timing of their number. There will be parent chaperones in each room to supervise the skaters before and after their number. The only exception to this policy will be for the Reindeer skaters, who can be picked up immediately after their performance.

No parents will be allowed in the backstage area for any reason unless they are chaperone or backstage volunteers (other than to drop off and pick up their skaters). Again, this is to ensure the safety of skaters and to minimize confusion in the back stage area.

Please make sure your child has skate guards and they are labeled with the skater’s name in order to avoid misplaced guards.

Note to Eden Prairie Figure Skating Club Members: If you typically leave your skates and guards in a locker in the Club Room, we recommend that you take them home with you after your last practice before the Thursday run-through and bring them with you when you come for the Ice Show performances.

ICE SHOW CHAPERONE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Parent chaperone volunteers are a critical component to keeping our skaters safe and the show running smoothly. These volunteers make sure skaters are safe, accounted for, and get to and from the backstage area at the proper time. Chaperoning is not a hard job, but without chaperones, the ice show couldn't go on.

Chaperone responsibilities include:

- Check skaters in as they arrive.
- Supervise skaters during the show.
 - Once skaters have checked in they must stay in the dressing room with their group until they are escorted to the rink for their performance.
 - Skaters will return to their dressing room after their performance and stay there until they are picked up by a parent or guardian at either intermission or the end of the show.
- Help remove skate guards before going to the ice and put skate guards on after the performance and make sure all jackets, gloves, etc. are left in the dressing room.
- Assist with last minute preparations.
- Keep gum, food and drinks out of the team rooms.

You may bring activities to keep the skaters busy. Some suggestions: A DVD player with age appropriate movie, CD player and music, crayons and paper, books, stickers, cards, etc.

For those who chaperone their own skater's group, you are still able to watch your skater's performance from seats near where the skater's go on the ice.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Skaters will return to their dressing rooms after their performance and will remain there until either intermission or the end of the show when they are picked up by a parent or guardian. This keeps our skaters safe and it minimizes the audience disruptions of parents and skaters coming and going during the performance. The only exception to this policy will be for the Reindeer skaters, who can be picked up immediately after their performance.
